1. ACRYLIC PAINTS

Liquitex or Golden brands. I don't recommend "student-grade" paint.

Cadmium yellow light, Cadmium yellow medium, Cadmium orange

Cadmium red medium, Magenta, Dioxazine purple, Cobalt blue

Turquoise, Phthalo green, Burnt Sienna (optional), Carbon or Mars black

Titanium white

2. BRUSHES

White nylon or bristle brushes:

#4 flat, #8 flat, #12 flat, #2 round, #10 round

Soft watercolor brushes:

#4, #6, #8

4. PAPER

One sketch pad, approx. 14X17"

Watercolor block (This is optional. Students may want to experiment with painting on paper rather than canvas, or use it for preliminary studies.)

3. CANVASES

Stretched canvases are best, but canvas boards are acceptable.

3-4 canvases, size and shape optional. I recommend around 16"x20" to 18"x24".

4. MISCELLANEOUS

"Stay Wet" palette with sponge and paper, 12"x16". This is a very important item. If you have trouble finding these in stores, they can be ordered from Masterson Art Products. Call 602 263-6017 or go to www.mastersonart.com.

Small spray-mist water bottle, Wide-mouthed container for water

Rags or paper towels, HB pencils, Charcoal (in vine and pencil form)

Kneaded eraser, Medium size kitchen sponge

Ruler or straight edge (optional)

Offset-blade palette knife
